KEY EXPERIENCE

Kennedy is a Director at DEVPART Consult and a Monitoring and Evaluation specialist. Kennedy worked with Government and the tea industry from 1991 when he graduated from University. In 1996-1998, Kennedy worked as a consultant on Community Based Organization projects, Kibera Tunaweza Community Development Program and as Executive officer, Environment Trust of Kenya. This involved fundraising and monitoring and evaluation of implementation of program activities.

Towards end of 1998-2001, Kennedy was a Project Assistant and Team leader at the University of Nairobi, Institute for Development Studies on various project research assignments. Kennedy also worked as team leader for a research project on waste management under Moi University, School of Environmental Studies.

In 2002, PricewaterhouseCoopers, Kenya was appointed to provide overall management of national Civic Education Programme in Kenya. Kennedy was a Project Officer (Monitoring and Evaluation) for PricewaterhouseCoopers in the National Civic Education Programme. Kennedy's focus was on program management and data verification and reporting.

In 2008-2009 Kennedy worked for a project known as Total War Against HIV/AIDS (TOWA). He was contracted as Monitoring and Evaluation and field operations manager by PricewaterhouseCoopers Ltd, Financial Management Agent for Kenya's National AIDS Control Council. His focus was on M&E systems strengthening, performance frameworks and field operations.

In 2003-to date, Kennedy has been also working as a sub-contractor for PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC) in monitoring and evaluation of the Local Fund Agent funded by The Global Fund to fight HIV/AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria. He has insight into how health programmes and policy making bodies function and overall strategies for the global fight against HIV/AIDS. He also understands the operations and mandate of National HIV/AIDS coordinating/policy bodies as well as those for Tuberculosis and Malaria in Africa. Kennedy has performed the capacity and system assessments for Principal and Sub recipients of Global Fund

grants in many countries including Kenya, Rwanda, Uganda, Zambia, Namibia, Tanzania, Zanzibar, Eritrea and Somalia.

PricewaterhouseCoopers Limited has been appointed the Local Fund Agents (LFA) of the Global Fund in the aforementioned countries for the past nine years. Kennedy has played the role of monitoring and evaluation expert on all the Global Fund engagements in the above countries. For institutional and programmatic, this work focuses on Legal status to enter into the grant agreement with the Global Fund; Effective organizational leadership, management, decision making and accountability systems; Adequate infrastructure and information systems to support proposal implementation; Adequate health expertise (HIV/AIDS, TB and/or malaria) and cross-functional expertise (finance, procurement, legal, M&E) review of principal recipients inter-linkages and offering suggestions for improvement. It also includes assessment of the Principal recipient's management ability on the Sub-recipients. It overall focuses on risks and mitigation factors.

For monitoring and evaluation, Kennedy's involvement includes performing monitoring and evaluation of systems on collection and recording of programmatic data with appropriate quality control measures; Support and preparation of regular, reliable programmatic reports; and making of data available for the purpose of evaluations and other studies by the PRs. In addition, Kennedy carries out programmatic monitoring on a quarterly/semester basis. This is by selecting a sample of reported achievements and traces the achievements to detailed reports from the implementing sites (service delivery points), occasionally visiting sites for onsite data verification and review of the project outcomes and impact after two years, making recommendations to Global Fund for approval of continued financing for the project (phase 2). Kennedy has also been involved in monitoring and evaluation systems strengthening in some of the mentioned countries including review of performance frameworks, monitoring and evaluation plans and national strategic plans.

For contracting and program management, Kennedy has been involved in supporting the preparation and signing of the grant agreement and carrying out a review of disbursement requests. This is by ensuring that the performance frameworks meet required standard and budgets are well linked to time and targets.

Kennedy has also been involved in piloting new OSDV checklist in Rwanda, new Rapid Service Quality Assessment checklist in Zambia and piloting new checklist for Country M&E profile in Kenya.
