
## Our Goal

### Risk Assurance and Advisory Services

Work in this area includes undertaking capacity assessments, as well as conducting independent reviews and verifications to identify key risks to achieving organizational and programmatic strategic objectives.

Our teams differentiate, categorize and prioritize risks based on the degree and impact of the risk, and recommend appropriate mitigation measures that also consider available resources / funding sources.

#### **Our risk advisory services focus on:**

- **Programmatic risks** - covering effective program design, quality of implementation, data quality, measuring impact, and social consciousness.
- **Governance risks** - assessing the structures and systems in place at the strategic / governance level to identify and respond to risks in a timely manner.
- **Operational risks** - reviewing and providing ongoing feedback on a comprehensive set of operational risks (people / talent management, business processes, policies and operational procedures, etc.) that may affect program implementation in line with a set standard of risk areas.
- **Financial risks** – assessing financial controls and systems and mapping out potential financial risks to foresee and propose actions to mitigate potential negative impacts on implementation.





## Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E)





PROJECT NAME, GEOGRAPHIC PRESENCE & RELEVANCE	DESCRIPTION OF WORK
<p><b>Review of the effects of the U.S. Government funding freeze on 12 African countries</b></p>	<p>DevPart Consult undertook a rapid situational analysis to assess the effects of the U.S Government’s funding freeze announced in January 2025 on 12 countries. The study analyzed the USG investments for each country and the contributions of these investments to national health funding by country. This was followed by country-level analysis of the projects that had been affected, and an assessment of the effects of the freeze on procurement and supply chain, information systems, human resources for health (HRH), laboratory services and service delivery across relevant programming areas: HIV/AIDS, Malaria, Maternal Child Health, Family Planning, TB, and Nutrition by country.</p> <p>Immediate effects were presented using quantitative and qualitative evidence, and further analysis was done pertaining to longer terms risks and threats. Countries covered included: Ethiopia, Kenya, Malawi, Mozambique, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia and Zimbabwe. The study was undertaken for the Gates Foundation’s Africa Regional Office.</p>
<p><b>Gates Foundation. GHI landscape assessment study for HSS grants</b></p>	<p>In 2024, DevPart Consult was commissioned by the BMGF Africa Regional Office (ARO) to conduct a Landscape Assessment study on health systems strengthening (HSS) in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), Ethiopia, Kenya, Nigeria, and Sierra Leone. This involved the rapid deployment of experts within these five countries to assess grants supported by three large Global Health Initiatives (GHIs) – Gavi, the Global Fund, and the World Bank’s Global Funding facility (GFF). Using the WHO HSS pillars as a review framework, DevPart Consult conducted extensive desk reviews and key informant interviews with standardized questionnaires to identify strategic opportunities for ARO to enhance the effective utilization of GHI funding.</p>
<p><b>The Global Fund. Deep Dive Review of 10 High Impact countries</b></p>	<p>In 2021, DevPart Consult a team of experts specializing in Public Health, Monitoring and Evaluation (PHM&amp;E), and Supply Chain Management (SCM) collaborated with finance experts in 10 high-impact countries across Africa and Asia, to investigate the root causes of low fund absorption for HIV prevention and Resilient and Sustainable Systems for Health (RSSH) interventions under the Global Fund portfolio. The study analyzed barriers to implementation, identified best practices, and provided actionable recommendations. Additionally, DevPart Consult developed a performance dashboard with drill-down capabilities, offering country-specific insights to enhance decision-making.</p> <p>The research aimed to improve the implementation of RSSH and HIV prevention activities. Covering the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), Ethiopia, Indonesia, Kenya, Malawi, Myanmar, Nigeria, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zimbabwe, the research highlighted key bottlenecks and proposed strategic solutions. DevPart’s findings and recommendations fed into guidance and processes for optimizing fund usage and strengthening health systems in these regions.</p>
<p><b>Close-out Evaluation - Southern African Development Community (SADC) Regional Global Fund Grant</b></p>	<p>Between November 2017 and February 2018, DevPart Consult conducted a close-out evaluation of the SADC Regional HIV/AIDS grant on behalf of the Global Fund. The evaluation aimed to assess grant management at both principal and sub-recipient levels, measure progress against the grant work plan, identify performance deficiencies, and evaluate the status of wellness clinics operating at various border locations. The study involved a comprehensive desk review, consultations with key stakeholders, and the development of assessment tools for site-level data of quantitative and qualitative data at 12 sites across seven SADC countries through interviews and focus group discussions including with beneficiary groups such as commercial sex workers and truck drivers. The evaluation covered key challenges, best practices, and lessons and provided recommendations to guide the grant closure process and inform future HIV/AIDS interventions in the regions.</p>

<p><b>The Global Fund Data Quality Review (DQR) Assessments</b></p>	<p>Since 2015, DevPart Consult has conducted targeted Data Quality Reviews (DQRs) for the Global Fund across multiple countries, including Uganda (2015, 2019, 2023), Ethiopia (2015), Guinea-Bissau (2018 for TB/HIV, 2019 for Malaria), Angola (2023), Eswatini (2023), and Mauritius (2024) utilizing methodologies aligned to the WHO guidelines tailored to each country context. The scale and scope, including number and distribution of sites, selection of indicators and components of the DQR to apply are informed by the client’s priorities and understanding of the risks. DevPart deploys specialized teams of M&amp;E and disease experts, often running concurrent field teams to efficiently execute assignments, with methodologies tailored to each country’s context and WHO guidelines.</p> <p>These reviews help strengthen national health data systems by ensuring accuracy, reliability, and alignment with global health reporting standards.</p>
<p><b>Mastercard Foundation Due diligence training - Ethiopia, Ghana, Kenya, Nigeria, Rwanda, Uganda, WAEMU, and Canada</b></p>	<p>In 2024, DevPart Consult was engaged by the Mastercard Foundation to enhance the due diligence and risk management capabilities of its Program Finance team. The training program, designed with practical and experiential methodologies, focuses on key areas such as partner screening, site visit assessments, and the evaluation of operational, financial, programmatic, and governance risks. It also provides guidance on conducting annual due diligence throughout program implementation and ensuring comprehensive risk assessment during program close-out, strengthening overall fund management and impact.</p>
<p><b>The Global Fund. Independent Data Quality Assessment (IDQA) for the Global Fund to fight HIV, TB and Malaria</b></p>	<p>Since 2022, DevPart Consult has provided independent quality assurance services for supply chain data in Ghana, Guinea-Bissau, Kenya, Tanzania, and Somalia on behalf of the Global Fund. Our role has been to verify the accuracy and reliability of data submitted by spot check service providers, ensuring it meets the required quality thresholds for analysis. By recollecting data from 10% of selected sites, we have helped assess the validity of previously collected data, providing confidence in its use for decision-making.</p> <p>This process enables the Global Fund and stakeholders to evaluate the reliability of spot check data, which informs critical decisions on health services and supply chain investments for HIV, TB, Malaria, and C-19RM grants. Through rigorous verification, DevPart Consult ensures that funding allocations and program strategies are based on high-quality, dependable data.</p>
<p><b>Aidspan. Training of Supreme Audit Institutions (SAIs)</b></p>	<p>DevPart Consult experts were part of Aidspan’s training teams responsible for developing materials and delivering programmatic audit training for health interventions funded by the Global Fund. The training was conducted for Supreme Audit Institutions (SAIs) in Kenya, Lesotho, Malawi, Namibia, Nigeria, South Africa, Zimbabwe, Tanzania, and Uganda, using diverse methodologies, including site visits, to enhance engagement and knowledge transfer.</p> <p>Delivered under a multi-partner collaborative project led by Aidspan, the training aimed to strengthen SAIs’ capacity to conduct financial, compliance, and programmatic audits of Global Health Initiative (GHI)-funded programs. Additionally, it sought to improve public financial management in global health by equipping African SAIs with the skills to advocate for better resourcing and accountability in government-managed programs supported by Gavi and the Global Fund, ultimately enhancing program performance.</p>

<p><b>DHIS2 Multi-country assessment LFA services -Ethiopia, Uganda</b></p>	<p>In 2018, DevPart Consult assessed the national health information and reporting systems (DHIS2) in Ethiopia and Uganda to evaluate their implementation and integration with TB, HIV, and Malaria data systems. The study aimed to identify reporting standards aligned with global monitoring practices, assess barriers to data utilization, and recommend cost-effective measures to improve reporting. It also examined the system’s capacity to meet Global Fund reporting standards, ensuring accessible data for program planning while promoting data ownership among health teams.</p> <p>The assessment identified gaps, deficiencies, and enablers influencing DHIS2 operations and explored alternative data sources to enhance verification efforts. It also analyzed data quality challenges and proposed sustainable interventions for improved accuracy and reporting. By highlighting best practices and lessons learned across various operational levels, DevPart provided strategic recommendations to strengthen DHIS2 systems and optimize disease reporting in both countries.</p>
